INVESTITURE CEREMONY: 27 OCT

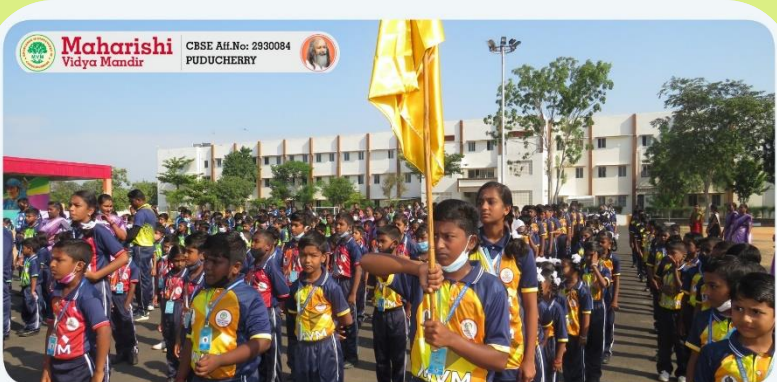
“Leadership is all about vision and responsibility, not about power.”

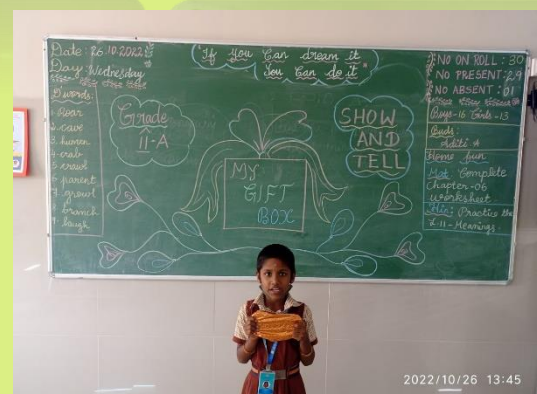
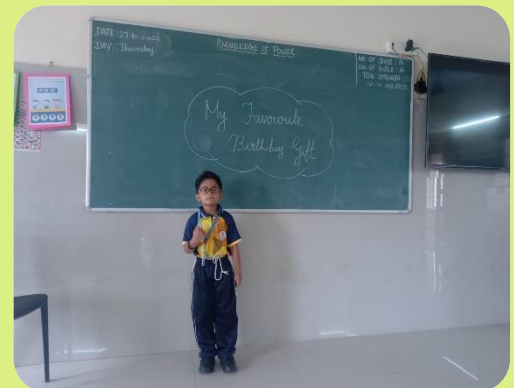
