



BRUSHING ACTIVTY: 02.08.2024

August 02, 2024, at Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Puducherry, our kindergarteners were engaged in 'the Brushing exercise activity' which helped them to enhance their understanding on dental health. The teachers let the students to experience the fundamental brushing techniques for a minimum of two minutes, which comprised of cleaning the top, bottom, right, and left areas of the mouth in a circular motion or thirty seconds every morning and evening. In order to facilitate the prevention of dental problems and bad breath, oral hygiene activities were thoughtfully incorporated into the teaching and learning process which also enhances their fine motor skills.
